The letters in the first half and the last half of the code are separately reversed to obtain the word.

Question: 2

If in a certain code, **SWITCH** is written as **TVJSDG**, which word would be written as **CQFZE**?

- (D) BREAD

Ans: D

Each letter at odd place in the word is one step behind and each letter at even place in the word is one step ahead of the corresponding letter of the code.

Question: 3

If in a certain language, **POPULAR** is coded as **QPQVMBS**, which word would be coded as **GBNPVT**?

- (A) FASOUM

(B) FOSAUM

(C) FAMOUS

(D) FAMSUO

Ans: C

Each letter of the word is one step behind the corresponding letter of the code.

Question: 4

If in a certain language, **GRASP** is coded as **BMVNK**, which word would be coded as **CRANE**?

(A) BQZMD

(B) XMVIZ

(C) GVERI

(D) HWFSJ

Ans: D

Each letter of the word is five steps ahead of the corresponding letter of the code.

Question: 5

If **EHFNRQ** is the code for **BECKON**, which word has the code **QDFWXULQ**?

(A) NACTURIN

(B) NACUTRIN

(C) NCAUTIRN

(D) NACUTIRN

Ans: A

Each letter of the word is three steps behind the corresponding letter of the code.
