Clearly, $D$ is to the left of $B$.


Question: 2
Which of the above given statements is superfluous?
(A) Six friends A, B, C, D, E and F are sitting in a closed circle facing the centre.
(B) E is to the left of D .
(C) C is between A and B .
(D) None of these

Ans: D
Clearly, in the circle the arrangement is as shown :
Since all the statements are necessary to determine the arrangement, none of them is superfluous.


Question: 3
Who is to the right of $C$ ?
(A) A
(B) B
(C) D
(D) E

Ans: A
Clearly, in the circle the arrangement is as shown :
Clearly, A is to the right of C .

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
